Brief Biography

Dr. Chen received his B.S. in chemistry from National Taiwan University and Ph.D. in cell biology from the Massachusetts Institute of Technology. He is Professor Emeritus of Pathology at Harvard Medical School.

Dr. Chen is the author of over 200 academic publications and is the founder of several successful biotechnology companies, including Fuji ImmunoPharmaceuticals Corp. and Shionogi BioResearch Corp. (both with Nobel laureate Dr. Susumu Tonegawa).

Dr. Chen has served as a Senior Consultant for numerous large pharmaceutical firms, and has led the development or consulted for more than a dozen drugs and drug candidates.

He was elected as an academician of the Academia Sinica in 1996.
